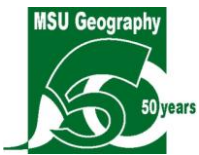
International Medical Geography Symposium

July 7-12, 2013

The Geography Department at Michigan State University invites you to the 15th IMGS on our campus in East Lansing, MI. Come for a fun and very productive symposium. Paper sessions will be held in the beautiful Kellogg Hotel and Conference Center, a 4-star “jewel of the hotels” right on campus. Our field trip includes a visit to extraordinary sand dunes from the glacial period and beach picnic on the shores of Lake Michigan, wine tasting at one of Michigan’s award winning vineyards, and dinner and entertainment at the FireKeepers Casino with transportation back to East Lansing throughout the evening.

We have two international airports for your convenience – Detroit Metro, Michigan and Chicago O’Hare, Illinois. From the Detroit Metro Airport you may connect to the Lansing Capital Region Airport or take the Michigan Flyer (luxury bus) to East Lansing. From the Chicago O’Hare Airport you may connect to the Lansing Capital Region Airport or take the Amtrak train to East Lansing. We will pick you up at the Lansing Airport and Michigan Flyer and Amtrak East Lansing sites and bring you to the Kellogg Hotel and Conference Center.

For those of you who would like to arrive early (Friday or Saturday), we will have city tours of Detroit and Chicago and also applied GIS workshops in the Geography Department.
