  - [10 pt] Reference and citation: through out your text, you should include citations for the subject that you mentioned, in the format like "Smith et al. (2013)". Also, at the end of the summary, add the complete references in format similar to this example, "Norris, J.P., Gehrels, N., & Scargle, J.D., 2010, ApJ, 717, 411". If there are more than two authors, use the phrase "et al." for authors beyond the first, as in: "Norris, J.P. et al., 2010, ApJ, 717, 411".

The complete reference does not count into the word limit.
