The GED Tests

The Online GED-*i* Preparation Class is designed to help you prepare to take the Official GED Tests.

The GED Tests, developed by the American Council on Education, are standardized tests designed to measure the major and lasting outcomes of a traditional high school education. The tests offer an alternative and acceptable way to earn a high school diploma. After you have passed the GED Tests, you will be awarded a Maryland High School Diploma by the State Board of Education.

The GED Tests are administered over two days at various locations throughout the State of Maryland. Testing is held during the second and third week of every month at most test centers.

When you and your teacher feel you are ready to take the tests, you will be sent a GED Test application with information about test locations and specific testing dates.

To be eligible to take the GED Tests, you must be at least 16 years old, not a high school graduate, have been officially withdrawn from a regular high school program for at least 3 months, and have been a Maryland resident for at least 3 months at the time of testing.
