Narrative Information

On May 28, 2016 at 1330 hours, Officer Lee responded to Wilkens Precinct for a walk in rape report.

Upon arrival Officer Lee spoke with the Complainant Katelyn Frank who stated that she needed to report a rape that occurred at UMBC on September 10, 2015. Complainant Frank said that on September 10, 2015 she was with her roommate Jennifer Matthews in the hallway of Patapsco Hall where Complainant Frank lived taking pictures of items in the hallway. Complainant Frank stated that she was approached by Joel Thomas who Complainant Frank advised that she engaged in a conversation with about taking pictures. Complainant Frank stated that Joel Thomas asked if she and her roommate Jennifer Matthews would help him hang up a tapestry in his room. Complainant Frank said that Joel Thomas had packages downstairs at the front desk so Complainant Frank followed Joel Thomas to get the packages. Complainant Frank said that one of the packages was a medium rectangle with an Amazon logo on it which had the tapestry in it. The other box was a small rectangle box which Complainant Frank stated once Joel Thomas opened contained pills which were white, oval shape and about the size of Advil. Complainant Frank said that she asked Joel Thomas what the pills were and he said that they were "focus pills" that is like Adderall, but better because you can stay calm and get stuff done. Complainant Frank advised that she felt the pills were sketchy, but helped Joel Thomas hang up the tapestry anyway. Complainant Frank afterwards stated that Joel Thomas grabbed a bottle of Malibu off his desk which was already opened. Complainant Frank said that Joel Thomas offered her a shot in which Joel Thomas poured some rum in it. Complainant Frank advised that Joel Thomas drank straight out of the bottle. Complainant Frank stated that Joel Thomas poured her another drink in the same cup. Complainant Frank said after her roommate Jennifer Matthews left Joel Thomas asked if she wanted to stay and watch a movie. Complainant Frank stated she felt awkward saying no to Joel Thomas and stayed anyway because of already feeling drunk.

Complainant Frank stated that Joel Thomas asked her to sit next to him on the bed in which Complainant Frank did. Complainant Frank said that Joel Thomas and her began drinking again. Complainant Frank stated that after watching the movie for about two minutes Joel Thomas began cuddling and touching Complainant Frank over her body. Complainant Frank stated Joel Thomas then began to kiss her and began to place his fingers inside her vagina three times or more. Complainant Frank stated that her memory fades in and out about certain details in which order they happened. Complainant Frank advised that Joel Thomas began undressing her when Complainant Frank said that she began to feel uneasy because of Joel Thomas undressing her but Complainant Frank stayed anyway. Complainant Frank stated that the next day she woke up in Joel Thomas's bathroom and noticed that there was blood everywhere. Complainant Frank advised that she was in extreme pain in her vaginal area. Complainant Frank said that she was a virgin prior to meeting Joel Thomas.

Complainant Frank stated that she believed Joel Thomas placed some type of drug in her drink.



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Complainant Frank said four days after the rape on September 14, 2015 she went to GBMC for a SAFE Exam. Complainant Frank was able to provide a copy of the SAFE Exam results which showed negative for any type of drugs in her system.

The SAFE Exam showed that Complainant Frank marked off the delayed report box.

Complainant Frank said that she also did not contact the Baltimore County Special Victims Unit within 90 calendar days from this date.

Complainant Frank advised that on Sept 14, 2015 she contacted Voices Against Violence (VAV) Program Coordinator, Rina Rhyne to report the incident. Complainant Frank said that an investigative report was conducted by an Independent Investigator who Complainant Frank was able to provide the investigative report findings.

Complainant Frank also provided a copy of a hair sample report analysis that she had done by X-Pertise Consulting in France.

Complainant Frank also provided a copy of a written statement that she wrote for her lawyer.

Officer Lee then went to UMBC and spoke with Sgt. Janney about any type of report from Complainant Frank about a rape and Sgt Janney said that UMBC has no record of any type of report from Complainant Frank.

Officer Lee also did a search though Baltimore County databases for Complainant Frank and found no record of Complainant Frank reporting this incident to Baltimore County Police prior to May 28, 2016.

In reference to the roommate Jennifer Matthews her name was the only information Officer Lee was able to gather from Complainant Frank.

Due to the time frame of when the alleged rape occurred there is no crime scene to process.

Officer Lee contacted the police liaison who advised that because of the time frame that Special Victim Unit would not be responding and have it just sent to them via FBR.

A copy of the Investigative report, SAFE Exam, Hair sample and written statements were sent to SVU via Departmental mail.
