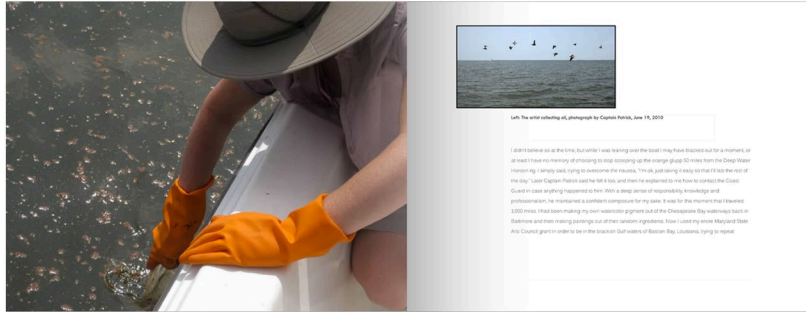


Marbleized Oil from the Gulf of Mexico
 Original photographs, prints and an essay.
 On day 50 of the BP oil spill where the Deep Water Horizon rig devastated the Gulf of Mexico, I went with fisherman Captain Patrick in his boat in order to collect oil samples in Bastian Bay, Louisiana. The day after I collected samples, June 20th 2010, I wrote an essay describing the experience. In July, I made over 20 marbled papers (22x30") exclusively from the collected oil, as well as over 50 postcards.
